The MIS emphasis curriculum is a pathway toward SAP TERP 10 certification – a valuable addition to your resume. In

Our relationship with SAP has grown where we are now one of two “mega hosting” centers serving more than 100 institutions in the SAP UAP. program with a strong grasp of business and the importance of keeping projects on time and under budget – something all businesses value. Students who complete an appropriate series of courses within this emphasis are prepared to sit for the Project Management Institute’s (PMI) CAPM or PMP certification exam. 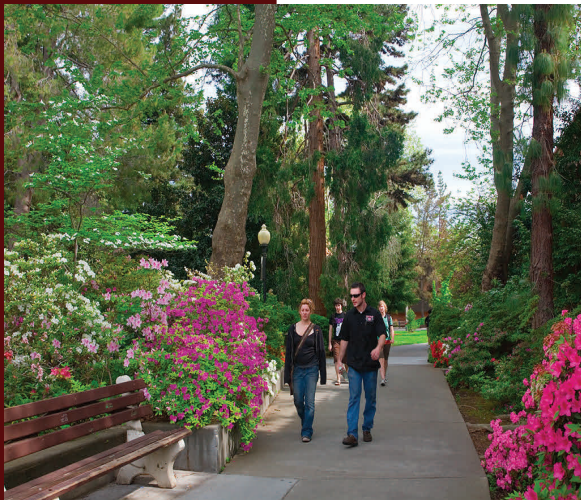
